CHAPTER 72: PARKING DURING SNOW EMERGENCIES

§ 72.01 SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTE.

The term *SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTE* shall mean any rural, arterial or collector street during a snowfall of two (2) inches or more of accumulation.

§ 72.02 PARKING PROHIBITED.

(A) It shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle on a Snow Emergency Route in the Village within 24 hours of a snowfall of two (2) inches or more of accumulation.

(B) It shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle in such a manner as to impede snow or ice clearing efforts by the Village of Deer Park or its authorized agents.

§ 72.03 REMOVAL OF VEHICLES AUTHORIZED.

Any vehicle parked on a Snow Emergency Route when parking is prohibited by Section 72.02 above may, at the order of the Kildeer Police Department, be removed to a storage facility previously designated by the Kildeer Police Department. Said removal shall be at the sole cost and expense of the owner of the vehicle.
